1. My unit needs repairs or maintenance.

2. I have a question or comment about the new construction planned for Parkside.



Send the project team an email at parkside@dhcmi.org or bring your comment to the next in-person community meeting.

3. When do in-person community events take place?



Residents will continue to receive mailed notification letters from DHC and Ginosko. We are aiming to host events at least once a quarter. Event notices will also be posted on the project website at dhcmi.org/villages-parkside so keep an eye out for updates! Updates will also be posted in the Community Center (5000 Conner) on the Resident Services Satellite Office door and the notice board.

4. Where can I see all public information available about the redevelopment?



Visit the project website (dhcmi.org/villages-parkside) or read the printed materials in the Community Center lobby (5000 Conner).

5. How do I apply to become a Community Advocate?



Visit the "Roles & Responsibilities" page on the website (dhcmi.org/villages-parkside) and scroll down to the bottom. You can download an application there and read a description of the position's responsibilities.

6. How can I obtain materials or ask my questions if I do not have access to the internet at my home?



Ask your question at one of the in-person community meetings.

OR: You can use computers for free at the Detroit Public Library. There is a branch at 12800 Harper, about a mile north of Parkside.

OR: Browse the printed version of the website materials in the lobby of the Community Center building (5000 Conner).
